

BCECA Surveys 2020

In accordance with its recently agreed and published objectives, BCECA has issued two surveys to its Members: an Industry Statistics survey and an IR35 survey. In recent years, BCECA members have had difficulties in providing the requested statistics because of the complexity of their global organisations and reporting lines. It was, therefore, decided to adopt a simplified approach for 2020 that would provide information that could be aggregated for use on the BCECA website and promotional material as well as lobbying etc. The purpose of the IR35 survey is to ascertain the percentage of contractors falling inside / outside IR35 in each Member company, so that the potential scale and consequences of BCECA Member companies not being aligned in their approach to IR35 status assessments can be determined.



BCECA MEMBERS' IR35 STATUS DETERMINATIONS

Background

The BCECA Board, Engineering Managers' and HR Managers' Committees have discussed the consequences of BCECA Member companies not being aligned in their approach to IR35 status assessments including rate rises and loss of contractors to competitors, overseas projects or retirement. They agreed BCECA survey should be conducted to ascertain the percentage of contractors falling inside / outside each Member company, so that the potential scale of the IR35 issue can be determined.

We, therefore, request that **all** members complete the below short survey. Non-contributors will not see the results of the survey.

All information provided will be treated in the strictest confidence and will not be attributable to individual companies as it will be aggregated to provide an overall picture of the IR35 situation.
