

BCECA AGM

On Tuesday 8th October, at the BCECA Council meeting and AGM, Dave Gibson, KBR, completed his two year term as BCECA Chair and was succeeded by Mark Stanton of Fluor.

During the Council meeting, the BCECA vote on the ECITB Levy Proposal was taken. Members voted in favour of the proposal by six votes to four. When combined with the votes from the other two employer associations, ECIA and OCA, plus the independent voting companies, there was a 75% majority supporting the proposal, which means that offsite levy rates will be incrementally increased from 0.14% to 0.33% over the three-year period from 2021 – 2023.



In the afternoon, Council Members were joined by BCECA Committee Chairs to review their activities and achievements over the past year and agree plans for the coming year. A demonstration of the new BCECA website that is due to be launched shortly was also given.
