At its meeting on 8th December 2020, the BCECA Council approved the final draft of the new BCECA five-year Strategic Plan ready for implementation in 2021. This coincides with BCECA's 55th anniversary and sets the direction for our Diamond Jubilee celebrations in 2026. BCECA will continue to lead, shape and drive discussion in pursuit of a sustainable and profitable future for the UK engineering contracting sector. Our five-year transformation plan is based on two central principles: relevance and commercial benefit to an enlarged membership. In pursuit of this and to drive the strategy forward, four new working groups will be established in 2021:

- ◆ Conferences and events
- ◆ Branding, communication, and marketing
- ◆ Energy transition and sustainability policy.


