On 7th December, the BCECA Board, Council and Committee Chairs came together face-to-face for the first time in almost two years for the BCECA AGM and Annual Review Meetings. It was a great opportunity to hear about and celebrate the hard work and achievements of BCECA and its committees and working groups over the past year.



BCECA's Chair, Mark Stanton, acknowledged that this had been a directional-changing year for BCECA, focussing on the implementation of the first year of the new five-year strategic plan, which had generated a huge amount of work and activity, culminating in the very successful inaugural conference in October. Malcolm Crawford, who had managed the conference content, confirmed that the Council had approved a second virtual conference for the Autumn of 2022, so a new working group will be convened early in the new year to begin preparations.
