Membership tiers

BCECA members are world leaders in engineering design, procurement and project management for the process and energy industries. They provide a global centre of expertise for international clients.

Our members are committed to high standards of corporate governance, sustainable development, and environmental protection. These standards are set out in the Association's new Charter adopted in 2021. **Acceptance of the Charter is a requirement of membership.**

BCECA is a discrete and trusted network that offers knowledge, intelligence and influence for engineering contractors and their partners. Three membership tiers are available.



Full Membership

This tier is open to companies who regularly undertake, as principal designer or contractor, contracts for engineering design, procurement, project management and/or construction of major energy, chemical, pharmaceutical, or other process plant facilities in any part of the world. A minimum of five years of activity in one or more of these sectors is required.

Full Members employ a substantial permanent engineering staff in the UK, across multiple disciplines, including **chemical, mechanical and electrical engineering** – excluding those employed on temporary contracts through agencies or other off-payroll working arrangements.

Associate Membership

Introduced in 2020, this tier provides a pathway for engagement with BCECA's knowledge networks at a reduced cost. Direct access to our global network of engineering contractors, information sharing, and collaboration is available to Associate Members.

UK registered companies with more than 15 personnel providing conceptual or niche specialist technical consultancy services to the process and energy sectors are invited to apply for membership, alongside vendors with a demonstrable track record of partnership and project delivery with EPC contractors.

Supplier Membership

Successful engineering contracting depends on a diverse range of goods and services. Suppliers make a crucial contribution to the sector. In 2021, BCECA initiated a new cost-effective route to membership for these companies.

Supplier Membership is open to companies selling goods and services into the broad range of EPC activity in which BCECA companies operate. UK registered enterprises supplying goods and services to the energy and process sectors are welcome to apply for membership in this tier.
