## Save the date for BCECA's 2024 Annual Conference

BCECA's 4th virtual annual conference returns in its established slot on the first Wednesday of October this year.

300+ participants are expected to join the free and fully online meeting, which will take place on Wednesday 2 October, with the first session going live at 0930 hrs (UK).

The conference will assess prospects for carbon capture and low-carbon hydrogen production in the UK - as well as their associated transport and storage needs - from the perspective of the engineering contracting companies tasked with delivering these strategically significant national infrastructure projects. The discussion will focus on the challenges and opportunities presented by the delivery of large-scale decarbonisation at a time of huge economic and political uncertainty.

Early speaker confirmations include a keynote contribution by Lord Ravensdale - a crossbench peer with a particular interest in energy policy. Lord Ravensdale will assess the political landscape for energy transformation in what is certain to be a general election year.

The afternoon session will open with a keynote from the Chair of the European Construction Institute, John Fotherby. John will examine contractual models for the successful execution of 'first of a kind' projects.

The provisional programme will be published Wednesday 15 May 2024, with registration opening on the same date.

The findings and recommendations arising from the conference will be presented at a reception in the House of Lords hosted by Lord Ravensdale on Tuesday 12 November 2024. All conference participants will receive an invitation to the reception.
